Through this prayerful strategic planning process, God's call and direction to empower the community resonated strongly.

Diamond Willow Ministries has a renewed commitment and clearer focus than ever before to pour ourselves mightily into God's redemptive and transformative work; empowering the youth, leaders and families of the Hunkpati Oyate community.

Upon much reflection and evaluation of past, current and potential future ministry programs and outreach, it was clear that one of the most effective and impactful manner in which we can be a part of God's work here is through what began just over two years ago now at the **Tokata Youth Center**.

# Diamond Willow Ministries is excited to announce that property has been purchased for the construction of a permanent Tokata Youth Center facility!



"Bursting at the seams" with youth is a daily blessing, and a challenge in the current facility.

The Tribe generously provides space in a Tribal building for Tokata Youth Center meals and programming to take place.

The dedicated Tokata Youth Center Staff do a fantastic job serving the youth as best as they are able within this very limited space.

A new permanent facility is much needed and will impact generations!!

#### THE LAND

There are very few available properties in Fort Thompson suitable for a youth center. Well, God is so good, the owner of the most suitable property agreed to sell. The second part of the equation was having funds to purchase it. God provided a very generous donation through a partner and friend of the ministry associated with Ashworth Road Baptist Church in West Des Moines, IA. The land purchase was finalized on December 30<sup>th</sup>, 2016!

The Crow Creek Sioux Tribal Council, and Tribal Chairman Brandon Sazue, were delighted to hear the news! Great trust and confidence is shown toward the ministry by community leaders that represent people that have had so many promises made and not kept. A mighty God is at work in this!

It was anticipated that the community would be very supportive, but the response has been exceptionally so! There has been tremendous support and thankfulness expressed for this purchase and the vision for a place for youth and families to come together.

Several community members stated that this is the single most exciting development that has happened in their lifetime within the community! Wow!! The hopefulness is tangibly felt within the community and incredible! The end product, the new Tokata Youth Center, will be a place that will empower and develop generations to come, but it is already having an impact right here and now.


GOD IS GREAT!

- Praise God for the opportunity to purchase the property and that everything came together so smoothly for it to take place.
- Several of the Diamond Willow Ministries and Tokata Youth Center staff members are dealing with critical health concerns and traumas within their close families. Please pray for God's healing and peace for all involved.
- Wisdom, and discernment for the staff as they focus on loving, supporting, and empowering the youth, families, and leaders within the community of the Crow Creek Sioux Tribe.
- Of course, please do keep the whole Tokata Youth Center planning process in prayer.
